pick someone up

odebrać kogoś

Can you pick me up at the airport at 6 a.m. tomorrow?

Czy możesz odebrać mnie z lotniska jutro o 6 rano?

see someone off

odprowadzić, pożegnać kogoś

A couple of my friends came to the airport to see me off.

Kilkoro z moich przyjaciół przyszło na lotnisko, żeby mnie pożegnać.

shut sth down

wyłączyć coś

The captain ordered the crew to shut the engines down.

Kapitan rozkazał załodze wyłączyć silniki.

take off

wystartować

The plane is ready to take off.

Samolot jest gotowy do startu.

touch down

wylądować

Please fasten your seatbelts, we'll be touching down in 10 minutes.

Proszę zapiąć pasy, będziemy lądować za 10 minut.

throw up

wymiotować

I spent the whole cruise feeling sea-sick and throwing up in my cabin.

Spędziłem cały rejs czując mdłości i wymiotując w kabinie.
